Tom Dingledine formed Bluff Point Holdings LLC in 2007 to hold the Bluff Point property in Northumberland County. Tom is the sole owner.

Tom's real estate involvement started in 1987 while working for a private holding company in Charlottesville, Virginia. The first projects he managed and developed were a student apartment complex in Charlottesville and a restoration of a former Chesapeake and Potomac passenger railroad station in downtown Charlottesville. In the mid 1990's additional real estate holdings were acquired ranging from commercial office/warehouse/retail buildings to raw land for commercial and residential uses.

Tom's prior work experience in commercial banking and managing a multi-company private holding company provided a solid foundation for leading his own companies. He was responsible for all dealings with his investment partners who invested in some of his prior real estate undertakings and in Virginia Exploration, Inc., a oil and natural gas well drilling operation Tom started in 1990. Since then, virtually all of the oil and gas assets and a drilling and production company he started in 1987 have been sold.

Tom has placed a large property in Albemarle County Virginia under a conservation easement with The Nature Conservancy and has supported The Nature Conservancy's Virginia Coast Reserve on the Eastern Shore of Virginia. Through a donor advised fund he and his family have been supportive of non-profits in Charlottesville and surrounding areas.

He holds an undergraduate degree from The University of Virginia and a Master's of Business Administration from Wake Forest University where he is a University Trustee. Honoring a unique family legacy he has been a strong supporter of James Madison University.

He and his family have enjoyed a home on the Chesapeake Bay since 2000 and have spent many days cruising the Bay.
